

2017-2018 School Immunization Requirements

Don't send them to school without their shots.



Vaccines keep kids safe in schools

Around the country, there are more cases of preventable diseases because parents are choosing not to get their kids immunized against preventable diseases. These diseases can spread easily in schools, but the good news is that vaccines are a safe and effective way of protecting your child.

Your child must be up-to-date on their shots to attend school

Your child must have at least one dose of all the required vaccinations – or the school can exclude them from attending. If your child isn't up-to-date on their shots, you'll have 5 days from the start of school to get the next dose, and provide a medical plan to get up-to-date.

Schedule a doctor's appointment this summer

Don't wait until school starts. Make a doctor's appointment. The doctor can see if your kid has the shots they need to attend school, and schedule any shots that your kid still needs.
