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# A Message From Dean Kristi:

Dear Families,

Everyday we get more news about how Covid-19 is spreading through our region. CHOP has released guidance asking schools in our area to go into fully virtual models if they aren't already (see <u>article</u>). They characterize our city's rates of infection as "catastrophic" and our Department of Health has said that the number of cases far exceeds their ability to effectively do contact tracing.

At Wissahickon, we have been offering a fully remote model with a few opportunities for in person contact and I have felt good about the safety precautions we have used to make those possible. Still, we can't ignore that we are operating within the larger context of a city in crisis.

We are making a few shifts immediately to allow for greater safety in this dangerous time. Please see the important message from our Director of School Operations, Tiffany Days-Harris, which shares new hours of operation for our buildings, materials pick up, and food distribution.

Further, we are suspending all in-person meet ups for the foreseeable future until the virus is more contained. This means that Kindergarten Forest Days on Fridays, as well as Specials in the Park by our Awbury Specialists will stop immediately. I'm sorry to share this news. I know that our students, families, and staff have so valued the chance to be together safely. Know that we plan to start these up again as soon as the virus is more contained. Stay tuned for more news about the plan for remote Specials on Wednesday-Friday.

I hope you have had a peaceful week, perhaps celebrating history in the making as our first Black, Asian, Female Vice-President was elected. Representation matters and it makes me hopeful for our future.

# Message From Tiffany Days-Harris Director of School Operations:

As Dean Kristi mentioned above for the safety of everyone, beginning Monday, November 16th the following changes will go into effect:

#### **Meals Distribution**
