It is imperative that you pick up the Chromebooks along with the below items in order to make sure students have what they need. Please see below for the additional materials you should be expecting for your student. Please also note that in order to get your new Chromebook, you must return your old one with its charger. If you cannot bring the old device on the day of pick-up, you have until November 16th to return it to the school.

Lastly, BEFORE YOU COME FOR MATERIAL PICKUPS:

For the health and safety of everyone we are asking that you self-check *before* you come to one of our schools. If you are experiencing or have experienced any of the following within the past 14 days: fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lost of smell, lost of taste, chills or body aches, PLEASE STAY HOME. Arrangements can be made for you to pick up your child's supplies at another time.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE FOR MATERIAL PICKUPS:

A member of our staff will do a temp check and ask you the following questions when you arrive at the school. We will also provide a pump of sanitizer, and provide a well-fitted face mask if needed.

- 1) Have you or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the last 14 days: sore throat, cough, chills, body aches for unknown reasons, shortness of breath for unknown reasons, loss of smell, loss of taste, runny nose, headache
- 2) Have you or anyone in your household had a fever at or greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit or had to take fever meds in the past 14 days?
- 3) Is anyone in your household sick?
- 4) Have you or anyone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?

5) Have you or anyone in your household traveled outside PA in the past 14 days?

If you answer yes to any of these questions, you will not be able to enter our schools at that time.


