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Message from CEO

Dear Families,

As the new trimester begins, we are all taking the chance to pause and take stock of how we're doing in remote learning. Now is a good time to sit down with your child(ren) and talk with them about school. Some questions you could ask your child in this moment are:

- How is school feeling for you right now? Do you look forward to joining in the morning?
- What's your favorite part of school? Your least favorite?
- What is something you have learned this year? What is something that you are working on learning?
- What could make it better for you?

Next week we have report card conferences and talking with your child(ren) now is a great way for you to prepare. All three days of report card conferences start with a morning meeting but then ask students to do their work asynchronously (on their own, off screen). This has made it possible for our conferences to be a little longer so teachers and families have the time they need to share and listen. We're looking forward to the chance to connect.


