Message from Principal

Dear Fernhill Families,

One thing we've been discussing as a staff is how to ensure that *all* of our students' identities are acknowledged and celebrated, including every student who identifies as Asian-American, Latino, Native American, white, mixed heritage or international heritage, in order to promote empathy among us all. Teachers are carefully considering texts and topics that provide both "mirrors" (learning about people similar to us) and "windows" (learning about people different from us) for all students.

We've also encouraged teachers to make time and space for students who would like to share their personal identity stories to talk with their peers, make a video about themselves, write a piece someone else reads - whatever they feel comfortable doing... with the goals of 1) having the chance to express themselves and who they are, and 2) raising racial/ethnic awareness of their peers. Please reach out to your child's teacher and/or Ms. Rebecca if you think they would be interested in this opportunity.
