# **Message From CEO**

Dear Families.

I hope you have had good weeks. There's still lots of important and fun left in our school year as we head into the last month! There is also once again an increased risk of Covid in our city and in our schools. As of Thursday (5/19) we have had 7 cases at the Fernhill campus. This is up from 2 cases last week which was up from 0 cases the week before.

Please read and follow the guidelines below:

- We have returned to mandated masking until further notice.
- You should send your child to school with two KN95 or medical grade 3 ply masks every day.
- Keep your child home if they have Covid symptoms.
- Many people who are testing positive have stomach and digestive issues. Do not disregard these symptoms.
- Continue to complete RUVNA every day even if your child is at home.

We are working hard to keep everyone in school in person but I will share that staffing and coverage are a challenge as more people test positive.

#### **Water Bottles**

Any students who lost their WCS water bottle needs to bring one from home for the remainder of the year. The school does not have any additional water bottles for students.

Flat Rate Program 2022-23 SY

The Department of Transportation Services will continue the Flat Rate Program for the upcoming 2022-23 school year. The payment amounts remain the same. There will be two enrollment periods. The first one will be open from May 16th to Wednesday, June 15.
