



Flat Rate Program Payment for 2022-2023 School Year

The School District of Philadelphia ("SDP") is continuing the **Flat Rate Program for the 2022-23 school year.** If you are not familiar with the program, it pays eligible families a monthly payment for transporting their child to school. The program is specific to families who are eligible for District-provided bus, cab or van services, and in-lieu of these services, choose to participate in the program. **Please note** - Participating families must provide their automobile's Vehicle Information Number (**VIN**) in order to qualify for payment.

Please see the attached communication that provides a detailed description of the program and what is needed from both the school and the families who wish to participate.

Please note - There will be two enrollment periods. The attached communication provides a link for the Enrollment Form. The Enrollment Form will not be accessible on the Flat Rate webpage until May 15, 2022.
