WCS Fernhill will have a Students Run Philly Style team again this spring! Students age 12 and older are encouraged to apply. No running experience is needed and the program is completely free of charge. All committed runners will receive an SRPS shirt and a pair of running shoes, as well as free race entries and transportation to-from school for races. Students need to commit to running 3 times per week (Tuesdays and Thursdays after school and Saturdays at Kelly Drive). A sports physical from the current school year is also required, but if you aren't able to get one, the program works with community organizations to get free ones. Due to funding limits, this year we can only accept 10 students for the team. Returning runners will have preference, and then the rest of the team will be selected by lottery. Initial applications will go out this week and are due to Ms. T by Friday January 20th. Please contact Ms. T for more information.


