At WCS, all K-6 students read independently in class every single day, but this is only half of the puzzle. To become truly proficient readers, they must also read every night at home. The reading log is a shared record of your child's reading life at home and at school. It lets you and the teacher know not only how long your child reads but what kind of a reader they are -- What books do they like? How fast do they read? Do they pick on book and stick with it or jump from book to book? The reading log is considered to be a part of every child's homework in every grade K-6, and it has a significant impact on their reading grade. Grades 7 & 8 have other reading related to their current language arts units, and all middle school families can find their children's nightly homework by clicking on links here.

Thank you for making the time to read with your child or check in on their reading every night. We can't do it without you!
