Report Card Conferences - Sign up by Friday, Dec 1

Dear WCS Parents: Report card conferences will be held on Wednesday, December 6th-Friday, December 8th. The "My Conference Time" site is up and running for you to schedule your conference with your child(ren)'s teacher. If you have uses the previous link please check your rsvp because some of the teachers schedules have changed and dates have been corrected. Follow these steps below to schedule:

- 1) Go to https://www.myconferencetime.com/wissahickoncharter
- 2) Click on the Fernhill campus
- 2) Click on the name of your child(ren)'s teacher.
- 3) Select the desired date/time for your conference by clicking on "Sign Up."
- 4) Submit the requested information then you will receive a confirmation email of your scheduled time.

Please sign up by <u>Friday</u>, <u>December 1st</u>. Any conference that is not scheduled by then will be automatically assigned to you. Note that you are only scheduling for your child(ren)'s homeroom teacher. If you want to schedule with any additional teachers, please contact them directly
