Thank you for supporting these hard-working kiddos at home by facilitating good sleep, healthy breakfasts, and timely arrival at school -- we had excellent attendance last week!

Most students have just one more day of math testing tomorrow, while our 4th and 8th grades will additionally take the science test next Tuesday 4/24 and Wednesday 4/25. Any students who missed any days will have make-up testing during the week of 4/30.

With PSSAs nearly behind us, we begin to see the end of the school year in the distance. These next two months are an important learning time, when Lower School classes explore juicy new topics and work on projects to consolidate their learning from the year. One way we do this is through our Sustainable Environmental Curriculum (SEC) Projects. Each class at Wissahickon will spend time in the coming months learning about a topic related to sustainability. First grade studies waste, second grade agriculture, third grade animals, fourth grade water, and so on. Students then design a service-learning project in which they use what they have learned to help the earth.

K-4th grade students must return their permission slips by <u>tomorrow</u>, <u>Wednesday</u>. <u>April 18</u>, in order to participate.
