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## **Essentials**

### WCS Residency Questionnaire

WCS is sending a Residency Questionnaire to all families to better serve families who qualify as McKinney-Vento. The McKinney-Vento Act provides services and supports for children and youth experiencing homelessness. You can find more information on pages 75 & 76 of your WCS Student Handbooks. This will be included in your Title I paperwork being sent home. You can also complete the form electronically <a href="HERE">HERE</a>. You only need to complete ONE form per family.

### Flat Rate Program Payment

Many of our families that have enrolled in the flat rate program have not received a confirmation email. Please complete the Parent Payment form found <u>HERE</u>. Please note you must complete this form <u>each month</u>. The school must also complete a payment form each month. The school payment form will be submitted by the 8th of each month. #### Tips From Our Director of School Culture For Monitoring Student Cell Phones

We know it's not the easiest job managing your child's cell phone with all the responsibilities on your plate. We want to support students to make safe choices with their cell phones (in surfing the web, group chatting, joining social media platforms, etc.) because we know they are susceptible to increased drama with friends and peers, predators, and an array of distractions from school and family time. Some families have found success with apps that allow them to mirror their child's phone so they can see who and what they're texting. These apps also include features that allow you to control how much time they are on their phone, filter websites, and monitor content.

- 1. Bark is one of the most popular family apps.
- 2. If your family all have Iphones, Apple has a family sharing app that has the same features as Bark.

3. Verizon also has a smart family feature for \$5 a month add on where you can also mirror and monitor your family's phone.

### 2022-2023 WCS Application

The 2022-2023 application cycle opened on September 24. As a reminder, families must apply to Wissahickon through the Apply Philly Charter System at <a href="applyphillycharter.org">applyphillycharter.org</a> or by calling 1 (800) 891-3999. Applications must be received by January 24, 2022 in order to be included in our lottery. As a reminder, WCS has sibling preference for applicants. A sibling is defined as a biological or legally adopted brother or sister who lives in the same household as the current WCS student. In the event the parent or legal guardian of a current student becomes the legal guardian of another child, sibling preference shall convey to that child. Applicants must also be Philadelphia residents in order to qualify for preference.


#### Fill out RUVNA when you get the text

# **Reminders**

### **Early Dismissals**

The latest early dismissal (except in true emergencies) is 2:30. No students will be allowed to leave class after 2:30 before their regular dismissal time. Families need to arrive at the school before students will be dismissed from class. Students cannot miss valuable learning time sitting in the lobby.

#### Late Pick Up Reminder

This is a reminder that when you are running late, please contact a staff member regarding your arrival time. Please do this even if you have contacted your child directly. Additionally, students in grades 1-8 are considered late for pick up after 3:50. Kindergarten students are considered late for pick up after 3:10. The late pick up fee is \$1.00/minute. This year, we waited until 9/20/2021 to enforce the late fee. We wanted to give our families time to make arrangements due to the various transportation challenges.
