Message from Dean Kristi

Welcome back everyone! It has been great to see everyone back at school.

As you may know, the city of Philadelphia has made several announcements in the last 24 hours. They ended the [indoor mask mandate](#) and also the [Covid-19 response levels that led to the mask mandate](#). At the same time, they shared that the city has elevated cases at this moment and that they strongly encourage indoor mask wearing. Because of this caution, all staff and students will be required to continue masking for one more week at minimum to get us further from spring break. We ask that you please send your child to school with a mask each day. We will absolutely stay in touch about any developments. I want to commend our

community on a smooth transition back to masks this week.

PSSA testing begins next week for all students in grades 3rd through 8th. In order for students to be able to do their best, we encourage you to make sure your student gets a good night's sleep, eats a healthy breakfast and arrives on time to school. It is important to be at school for testing days but we remind everyone to complete the Ruvna daily screening. If your student is experiencing any COVID symptoms they should be reported and remain at home. Students who are absent will have an opportunity to make up the test at a scheduled time during the testing period.

To encourage students to do their best we will have daily raffles for attendance and for showing academic

excellence during the test. Please talk to your children about trying their best, staying focused, and using all their test taking strategies (challenge them to name a few!). This test is especially important for our 7th graders as it can be used for high school admissions.

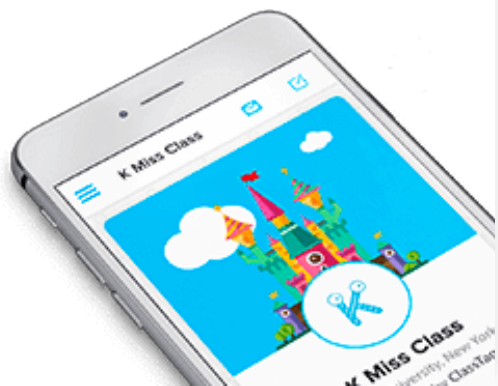
