# Wissahickon in the Wissahickon is happening again!!

If you are new to this school, Wissahickon in the Wissahickon is an all day (depending on the grade) field trip to Bluebell Meadow. It is a time to celebrate our mission as a whole school. Your children will partner with younger or older grades to build our community connection and enjoy a hike, art and reading in the meadow, a fun game of kickball, and yoga/meditation!

Wissahickon in the Wissahickon will happen with all our 01\* classrooms on May 13th and all of our 02\*\*classrooms on May 20th leaving between 8:30 and 9:00 and getting back by 1:00 unless your child is in 5-8. (\*K1 & 601 will go on May 20th \*\*K2 & 602 will go on May 13th)

Grades K-3 will ride a bus there and back Grades 4-8 will walk there. Grades 5 and 6 will walk there and back.

All 7 and 8th graders will have an extended time at the park and leave from there on Septa, unless you choose for your 7th or 8th grader to opt out of riding Septa straight home. If you opt out your 7th/8th grader, let their homeroom teacher know ASAP, so that we can arrange for them to walk back to school with a 5th and 6th classroom.

Because of the size of this event, every child will attend, unless you choose to opt out your child. If you choose to opt out your child for this field trip, we are requesting that you provide

us with notice by Tuesday, 10th so that we can make adequate preparations for how they will spend time here at the school.
