#### WCS Device Insurance

November 10 - Awbury and Awbury

Wissahickon families, we are extending the time allowed to buy insurance for your student's device. (5th-8th Grade) (Deadline, October 31st)

While it's not required, we strongly encourage all families with Chromebooks to participate in the insurance program.

The cost for device Insurance through WCS is \$27/device. The device Insurance you purchased covers the following;

- Damage caused by accidental drops and spills
- Accidental water damage
- Loss/Theft

There are no deductible costs for families associated with qualified repairs. Families are entitled to a total of THREE (3) accidental damage claims per school year for each insured device. Manufacturer defects and hardware failures are covered by the device manufacturer.

The insurance does NOT cover the following

- Damage caused intentionally or through extreme neglect.
- Any device that indicates an attempt to remove or removal of the labels or tamperproof stickers.
- Any device that was not issued to the student.

\*When a WCS-issued device needs repair, your student can bring it to the building they attend. Students will be issued a temporary loaner device if one is available that will remain at school until which time their originally issued chrome book is repaired and returned. Please allow 10-15 days for repairs. Depending on the type of repair that's needed and the

availability of parts some repairs can take up to 4 weeks or longer. Once the repair is complete your student will be contacted to return the loaner device and receive their original device back. For students/families that do NOT invest in this insurance program, in the event of accidental damage, Chromebook repair costs will be added to the student account and families will be notified. Families that do NOT participate in the insurance program that has a damaged Chromebook will NOT be able to participate in the insurance program until the damaged Chromebook is repaired. For reference, the most common damage to a device that needs repair is the screen. Repair costs for a screen replacement (when not covered by insurance) average \$80. Other, less common, repairs range from \$100 to full device replacement at \$260. Determination of whether the damage is considered "intentional" or due to "extreme neglect" will be made by a full-time staff member of the Technology Services Department.

#### **Awbury Insurance**

Please note the child(s) name when submitting payment to the school.

#### Morning Drop-off Begins at 8am (not earlier)

There is no supervision for students before 8am. We require that you wait until this time to leave your child at school. Safety is a serious concern for children left at school before 8:00a.m. The supervising adults do not report to their stations until 800a.m. Therefore, students will NOT be permitted to enter the building prior to 8:00 a.m. The gate will open for cars at 8 AM.
