I hope you have a wonderful winter break full of happy moments with your wonderful children. As we prepare for a healthy return from the Winter Break, please note the following:

- WCS will have a mask mandate for 10 days following the Winter Break. The mask mandate will be in effect from January 4th thru January 13th.
- In addition to the mask mandate, all students will be sent home with a Covid test. Covid tests will be sent home, Wednesday, December 21st. The Covid test should be administered on Wednesday, January 4th BEFORE your child's arrival to school. Negative test results do not need to be communicated to the school. No news is good news! Additionally, our sales translate to a profit of \$3,167.02 of Scholastic Dollars for the school. This money helps us update the library collection with great new books and other resources. Additionally, this funding can support purchases of classroom books and help us support students at future Fairs who may not be able to afford to buy a book. Essentially, these funds will help us build and strengthen a love of reading within our students by giving them access to even more fantastic books and resources.

A huge thank you to all for being a part of getting books into the hands of our students.


And a special thank you to all the parent volunteers who gave their time to help us set-up, run, and clean-up the Book Fair. It would not have been possible without you!
