# Message from Director of School Operation

Dear Families,

While we are in the thick of cold, covid and flu season our continued goal is to keep our students safe. We appreciate and continue to need your partnership in being successful with this endeavor.

Below are a few reminders to keep in mind for the second half of the school year:

- -Students are never allowed in school with an active fever (100.4 or higher) and must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication in order to return to school.
- -If your child has been deemed too ill to remain in school by the school nurse, please make arrangements to have your child picked up promptly. We encourage families to plan ahead for these medical emergencies.
- -If your child is not feeling well **BEFORE** school, please keep them home.
- -If your child has covid like symptoms, be sure to test them for covid and alert the school at <a href="mailto:acnurse@wissahickoncharter.org">acnurse@wissahickoncharter.org</a> of any <a href="mailto:positive">positive</a> results.
- -While there is no school-wide mask mandate, your child is welcomed to wear a mask sent in from home.


