Have your child practice naming sight words automatically. Mix it up! Practice these words in a variety of ways:



  - Discuss words as you read. Stop and talk about an interesting word and use it in context for your child to understand the meaning.
  - Ask your child to describe the main character, the problem and solution, and the lesson of the stories you read.
