Summer Reading

- 2. **Practice sight words** Students should complete **2 pages in their Fry Words packet** per week (this is the second half of the summer reading packet).

 - Discuss words as you read. Stop and talk about an interesting word and use it in context for your child to understand the meaning.
 - Ask your child to describe the main character, the problem and solution, and the lesson of the stories you read.
