Below are some updates for the 2025-26 school year. These changes have been added to our school Wellness Policy that can be found on our website.

The Wellness Policy is to ensure the health & well being of all students at all times during the school day, and all staff are a part of making this happen.

Some of the changes include:

- Classroom Birthdays / Celebrations No cupcakes or cakes will be allowed. All snacks MUST pass the Smart Snack Product Calculator https://foodplanner.healthiergeneration.org/calculator/ AND MUST be approved by the Food Service Coordinator.
- (1) celebration per month per classroom at the discretion of the teacher.
- Parties/celebrations shall include foods or beverages that meet established nutrition standards. Parents/Guardians will be informed through newsletter or other efficient classroom communication methods of what foods/beverages should be brought in when a party has been scheduled.
- No pizza parties We will work with the kitchen for a healthier alternative.
- Sales of foods & beverages that meet the smart snacks standards and sales of nonfood items (e.g., wrapping paper, plants, apparel or items that need to be baked at home cookie dough) are not limited under the Federal policy.
- Fundraising activities that occur during nonschool hours, on weekends, or at off-campus events are not limited under the Federal policy.
